The candidate will serve as a business partner and provide day-to-date support on legal matters to the European General Manager and the Clinical, Commercial, Regulatory and Medical Affairs business leaders in London as well as liaise with senior managers based in the Brisbane, California Head Office. The position will coordinate and interact frequently with other Legal department members in Brisbane, California.

- Lead the UK/EU Legal contracting function as part of the global Legal team;
- Draft, review and negotiate agreements and ancillary documents customary to a fast-growing, clinical-stage, pharmaceutical company including:
  - Clinical trial agreements for multiple trials
  - Informed Consent Forms compliant with UK and EU requirements
  - Clinical vendor agreements
  - Supply agreements for clinical and commercial supply of products
- Create, update and maintain contract templates while working within the company's existing contracts request system and database
- Lead the UK/EU's data privacy compliance efforts, including compliance with the GDPR
- Prepare and deliver relevant training as necessary within Aimmune.

- Provide advice on UK and EU healthcare compliance matters;
- Manage corporate governance and compliance for the company's international subsidiaries;
